

**AMA medical “code of Ethics” PROVIDES ALL 3 vaccine exemptions for Medical DOCTORS (sec. 8.7- pg. 6)**

***“Particularly a disease which has potential to become epidemic...and for which there is an available, safe and effective vaccine, a physician should: accept immunization ABSENT a recognized MEDICAL, RELIGIOUS, or PHILOSOPHICAL EXEMPTION.”***

**AMA medical “Code of Ethics” also REQUIRES REPORTING OF ADVERSE EVENTS** even though doctors RARELY report vaccine reactions! (Sec. 8.8, pg.7) This section clearly states that very ***FEW reactions will appear to be “clearly causal”*** but that **THERE is an “ETHICAL RESPONSIBILITY” to REPORT ALL SUSPECTED REACTIONS** and to:

- 1.) ***“Communicate that information”*** through ***“established reporting mechanisms”***. And....
- 2.) To ***“promptly report serious adverse events*** requiring hospitalization, death or medical intervention to the appropriate medical regulatory agency”.
