**Statement for WTVD ABC 11, Durham, North Carolina  
regarding NC State Bar vs Attorney Allan Phillips Case**

Ohio Advocates for Medical Freedom (OAMF), a non-profit and non-partisan organization, and one of the nation's prominent health freedom groups, is leading a national effort of 74 health freedom organizations in a call for an independent investigation of the North Carolina State Bar. These organizations represent hundreds of thousands of citizen activists throughout the country.

In February of 2017, the NC State Bar issued a Letter of Warning to NC Attorney Alan Phillips, who advocates for health freedom activists nationally. In late 2017, a number of organizations – including OAMF - filed complaints with the NC State Bar Grievance Chair. These organizations believed that the letter received by Phillips, from the Bar, contained false information, and that the action of issuing the letter to Phillips was unethical and an act of misconduct.

These organization's formal complaints filed against the NC State Bar Grievance Chair, in October of 2017, have been illegally dismissed by an internal review process of the Bar. However, the State Bar can't investigate complaints against its own employees, according to NC State Law, established by Legal precedent, that says NC State Bar can't investigate itself: *Boyce v. N.C. State Bar*, 814 S.E.2d 127 (N.C. App., 2018) [See concurring opinion](#). OAMF can verify that their complaint filed against the Bar was dismissed without appropriate review.

In response to the alleged NC State Bar misconduct, OAMF is leading a national grassroots project that has resulted in thousands of emails, letters, and phone calls from concerned citizens around the country to NC State officials in all three branches of NC state government, demanding an independent investigation of their and Phillips' complaints against NC State Bar attorneys.
